

POST-TRAVEL AND POST-GATHERINGS POLICY (UPDATED)

1. A **staff member** may return to school after a) receiving a negative PCR COVID test (not a rapid test) that is administered ***five days*** after returning from travel away from his or her primary residence, or participating in a gathering with people outside his or her own household ***and*** b) quarantining for seven days after possible exposure, ***and*** c) being **symptom-free**.

2. A **student** may return to school after:

- a) receiving a negative PCR COVID test (not a rapid test) that is administered ***five days*** after returning from travel away from his or her primary residence, or participating in a gathering with people outside his or her own household ***and*** quarantining for seven days, OR
- b) may return to school without a test after quarantining for 10 days after traveling or gathering as above. **In both cases, the student must be symptom-free.**

TODDLER MASK POLICY (NEW)

As an added safety precaution and in keeping with CDC guidelines, toddlers aged 24 months and older will be required to wear a mask in school beginning Monday, January 4, 2021. They will join staff members and students at all other levels, who have been wearing masks since the start of school.

SHORT-TERM VIRTUAL LEARNING PARAMETERS (GRADES 1-8) WHILE SCHOOL IS OPEN
(CLARIFICATION)

While school is being conducted in person, for students who are not usually enrolled in online learning to participate virtually, the teacher must be notified 24 hours in advance, and the student must be absent for two days or more.
